

NAVIGATING THE AGED CARE SYSTEM

Do you, or a loved one need help navigating the aged care system? We can help!!

The ACT Disability Aged Carer Advocacy Service (ADACAS) is proudly continuing to work with the Council on the Ageing (COTA) until December 2022 to see how people are navigating aged care home services and support through My Aged Care (MAC).

Eligibility to access MAC is open to all Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander people aged 50 years or older, all non-Indigenous people aged 65 years or older and Prematurely Aged individuals (50 years or older for non-indigenous people and 45 years or older for Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander peoples).

ADACAS Aged Care Navigators provides a free My Aged Care information service to eligible individuals, their families and carer's, in person, by phone or by videolink. We can also coordinate the help of the Translating Information Services for people from linguistically diverse backgrounds or with auditory impairments.

COTA ACT Silver is Gold Seniors Expo Gathers Momentum

While Canberra's seniors might well remember the postponement of the COTA ACT Seniors Expo, due to the COVID-19 lockdown in March 2020, it was always the intention to re-schedule later in 2021 and to take advantage of staging the Seniors Expo to coincide with Floriade, another important event on the Canberra seniors' calendar.

With the rapid progression of the COVID-19 vaccination program in the ACT and the prospect of COVID outbreaks diminishing, COTA ACT have taken the responsible decision to deliver the Seniors Expo on Thursday 16 September 2021 at Exhibition Park in Canberra (EPIC), situated on Flemington Road, Mitchell, close to the Transport Canberra, bus and light rail stations.

COTA ACT have also decided to expand the Seniors Expo by creating a second pavilion, to enhance and diversify the overall attraction to seniors and to allow a greater degree of social distancing.

The Coorong Pavilion, which is linked to the Budawang Pavilion, will feature lifestyle and recreational interests, displays and stalls that will include art, photography, craft, hobbies, bonsai, gardening advice, sustainable living and gardens, environmental information, seniors nutrition, regional gourmet food and wines, dance and music performances, regional tourism and other activities that are on offer to seniors in the Canberra region.

Seniors who visit the Expo, can wander through the Coorong and Budawang pavilions with ease, absorbing information on services, products, features and displays in the stalls that are located within each pavilion.

One significant change from previous Expos will require seniors who would like to attend the Expo, to book for either a morning or afternoon session, of a maximum three hours in duration. Ticketing has been implemented to great success, in the delivery of the seniors expos in other parts of Australia, to ensure the safety and wellbeing of seniors.

The morning session will commence at 9.00am and conclude at 12.00pm. Expo visitors who have attended the morning session, will then depart the Expo site, to enable a special cleaning team to perform a thorough COVID-preventative cleaning operation, in readiness for the afternoon sesson, which will commence at 12.45pm and conclude at 3.45pm.

Canberra seniors who would like to attend the Expo, must book their tickets through the Eventbrite booking platform, prior to the Expo, with a choice to attend either the morning or afternoon session. There are 4,000 tickets allocated for each session, with admission and parking being absolutely free. The link to register for the Seniors Expo can be found at: https://seniorsexpo2021.eventbrite.com.au

Expo visitors will enter the Expo through the Budawang Pavilion main entrance doors, have their tickets checked, complete the scanning procedures, using the Check-in CBR QR code for the Seniors Expo, have their temperature checked, befoe they are admitted into the pavilion.
